## Competition Rules

- Competition will be governed by SOBHD rules.
- Competitors must have a current 2009 FUSTA card or ScotDance registration card to compete. Competitors should present card at time of registration. Registered dancers who do not have their cards with them may dance, but any awards won will not be given out until the dancer has shown card or a copy to the organizer. A fee of \$5.00 will be charged.
- Change in classification must be received by October 31, 2009.
- This is a non-refundable entry.
- Organizers reserve the right to cancel, split or combine, add events or makes changes within the SOBHD rules.
- Competitors will dance in inverse order of entry.
- All competitors are expected to comply with FUSTA Code of Ethics.
- Any dancer causing delay will forfeit entry in any event.
- Any attempt to approach a judge or piper on behalf of a competitor may result in disqualification.
- Dancers **must** be in competition dress to accept all awards.
- Decisions of the judge are final. Protests must be made in writing and submitted to the Executive Secretary with a fee of \$5.00 before the end of the competition. Fee will be returned if protest is sustained.
- All dances count toward aggregate trophies.
- Aggregate trophy is awarded to the dancer in their class and age category with the highest points in all dances.
- Primary dancers will receive medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> places, and participation awards.
- Pre-Premier dancers will receive medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> places and aggregate trophies based on age group and category.
- Premier class will receive cash awards and aggregate trophies based on the number of dancers and age group.
- The 15 & under and 16 & over Premier prize money is 1<sup>st</sup>, \$100, 2<sup>nd</sup>, \$50, 3<sup>rd</sup>, \$25, 4<sup>th</sup>, \$10.
- The **Jean Donnachie Memorial Trophy** is a perpetual trophy awarded to the Premier dancer who has earned the most aggregate points. Less than six Premier dancers within each age group will require a dance off for the trophy.
- The **Most promising Pre-Premier Dancer of the Day** \$25 scholarship is awarded to the most promising Pre-Premier dancer by Judge's choice.
- The **Terry Burke Memorial Award** is a perpetual plaque and \$25 scholarship awarded to the Pre-Premier dancer for the best performance by Judge's choice.
- Dancer must compete in Saturday competition in order to participate in the Saturday or Sunday workshops.
