Judge and Workshop Instructor Diane Krugh

Diane MacPhee Krugh has been teaching Highland for over 37 years and for the past 29 years has been the Dance Director at St. Thomas Episcopal School in Houston, Texas where she teaches Highland Dancing on a full time basis along with her sister Donna Cusack. Together they have produced seven different United States Champions winning twenty-three US Championship titles. On several separate occasions, their students have been in the top six overall places in the Juvenile Junior and Adult World Championships, as well as winning many other Championships in Canada and Scotland. In 1997, one of their students Michelle Cumagun won the Juvenile World Championships. Diane travels on a regular basis conducting workshops and has adjudicated at many competitions and Championships all over the United States, and in, Australia, Canada, New Zealand, Ireland and Scotland. Diane is an Examiner with a Fellow in Highland and National Branches with the BATD and a member of the SOBHD's Judges Panel. She is happily married for 33 years and has a 27 year-old son, Neil, and a 17 year-old daughter Sandra

Competition Rules

- Competition will be governed by SOBHD rules.
- Competitors must have a current 2011 FUSTA card or ScotDance registration card to compete. Competitors should present card at time of registration. Registered dancers who do not have their cards with them may dance, but any awards won will not be given out until the dancer has shown card or a copy to the organizer. A fee of \$5.00 will be charged.
- Change in classification must be received by October 29, 2011.
- This is a non-refundable entry.
- Organizers reserve the right to cancel, split or combine, add events or makes changes within the SOBHD rules.
- Competitors will dance in inverse order of entry.
- All competitors are expected to comply with FUSTA Code of Ethics.
- Any dancer causing delay will forfeit entry in any event.
- Any attempt to approach a judge or piper on behalf of a competitor may result in disqualification.
- Dancers **must** be in competition dress to accept all awards.
- Decisions of the judge are final. Protests must be made in writing and submitted to the Executive Secretary with a fee of \$5.00 before the end of the competition. Fee will be returned if protest is sustained.
- All dances count toward aggregate trophies.
- Aggregate trophy is awarded to the dancer in their class and age category with the highest points in all dances.
- Primary dancers will receive medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places, and participation awards.
- Pre-Premier dancers will receive medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places and aggregate trophies based on age group and category.
- Premier class will receive cash awards and aggregate trophies based on the number of dancers and age group.
- The 15 & under and 16 & over Premier prize money is 1st, \$60, 2nd, \$30, 3rd, \$15, 4th, \$10.
- The **Jean Donnachie Memorial Trophy** is a perpetual trophy awarded to the Premier dancer who has earned the most aggregate points. Less than six Premier dancers within each age group will require a dance off for the trophy.
- The **Most promising Pre-Premier Dancer** \$25 scholarship is awarded to a dancer in the Pre-premier categories: Beginner and Novice. The winner will be determined by dance-off between the first place recipients in the Beginner and Novice classes. The qualifying dance will be drawn the day of competition from the Fling, Sword, and Sean Triubhas. The dance drawn as the qualifier will also be the dance competed for the dance-off.
- The **Terry Burke Memorial Award** is a perpetual plaque and \$25 scholarship awarded to the Pre-Premier dancer for the best performance by Judge's choice.
- Dancer must compete in Saturday competition in order to participate in the Saturday or Sunday workshops.
